Figures for March showed a decline only in New South Wales;

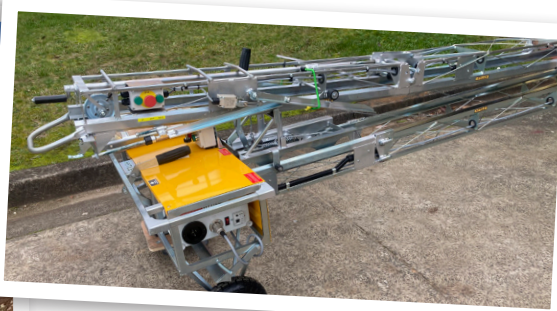
SA +14.2% WA +10.3% VIC +10.1% QLD +2.3% NSW -21.6%

Some of the great ideas you've given us to put into practice over the years are the SNAP-CONNECTOR (which allows the Cable Hoist to fold-out and snap into place ready to go), and the BASE WHEEL BRAKE (which keeps the machine base from moving whilst in operation). More recent developments have been an EXTRA-LONG 2-section machine that reaches a further 1.2m up

the roof (but remains the same length when folded for transport), and a SHORT 2-section machine that's perfect for single storey jobs.

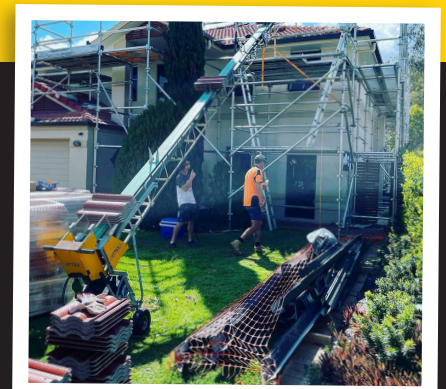
RIDGE COVERS

The versatile Folding Belt Elevator is available in both petrol and electric models. Both the 6.5m and 10m models can be increased in length by adding in extra sections. The auto-stop lever at the top allows you to work at your own pace by bringing the belt to a halt if the tiles haven't been removed at the top. Belt Elevators can deliver around 3,500 - 4,500 tiles to the roof per hour, however the loading rate for most gangs is usually around 2,500 per hour.

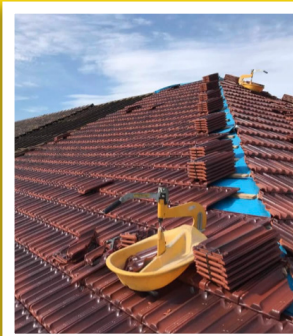


TAFE APPRENTICE AWARDS
